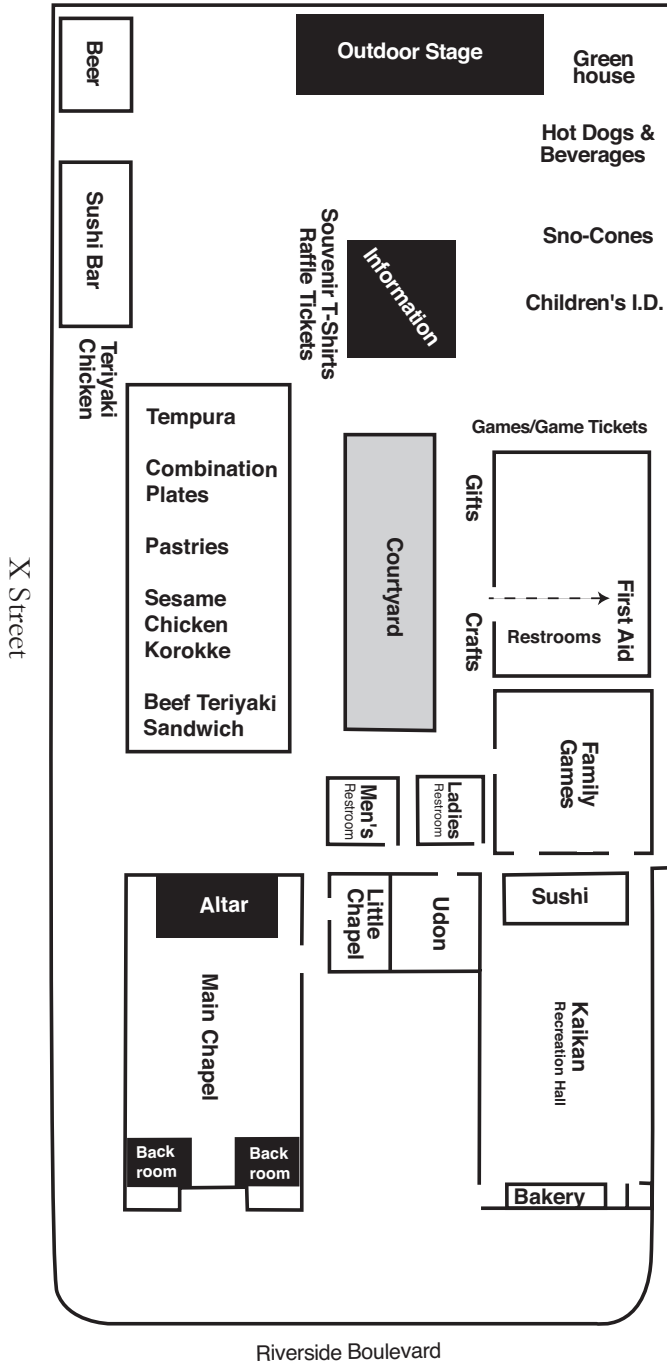


*Floor Plan of the Sacramento
